Abstract Submission

Guidelines:

1. Original research abstracts must use the following format:
 - Introduction & Objectives
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions
2. The (body) of the abstract is limited to 500 words including spaces. An abstract that exceeds this limit will be rejected.
3. An abstract must have a short, specific title (containing no abbreviations) that indicates the nature of the investigation.
4. The abstract cannot contain illustrations, images, or graphs. If the abstract is accepted, presenters can include these items in their onsite presentations.
5. Please thoroughly proofread your abstract before submitting it. Once an abstract is submitted, it cannot be modified.

6. Last day for abstract submission is **Friday, January 15th, 2016**
7. Abstract authors will be notified of their status, including whether they have been chosen to participate in the Oral Presentation by Saturday, January 23rd, 2016
8. All communications regarding the abstract submission will only be directed to the **submitting author**.
9. One of the authors (at least) must be present to discuss the research during the scheduled judging period.
10. By submitting an abstract and/or poster, you certify that
 - (1) The research, abstract and poster are your original work or original work conducted by you and other authors; and
 - (2) All co-authors are appropriately credited for their contributions and have been informed of the submission. Violation of these requirements will result in disqualification from the conference.
