## **Abstract Submission**

## Guidelines:

- 1. Original research abstracts must use the following format:
  - Introduction & Objectives
  - Methods
  - Results
  - Conclusions
- 2. The <u>(body)</u> of the abstract is limited to 500 words including spaces. An abstract that exceeds this limit will be rejected.
- 3. An abstract must have a short, specific title (containing no abbreviations) that indicates the nature of the investigation.
- 4. The abstract cannot contain illustrations, images, or graphs. If the abstract is accepted, presenters can include these items in their onsite presentations.
- 5. Please thoroughly proofread your abstract before submitting it. Once an abstract is submitted, it cannot be modified.

- 6. Last day for abstract submission is *Friday, January15<sup>th</sup>, 2016*
- Abstract authors will be notified of their status, including whether they have been chosen to participate in the Oral Presentation by Saturday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2016
- 8. All communications regarding the abstract submission will only be directed to the **submitting author**.
- 9. One of the authors (at least) must be present to discuss the research during the scheduled judging period.
- 10. By submitting an abstract and/or poster, you certify that
  - (1) The research, abstract and poster are your original work or original work conducted by you and other authors; and
  - (2) All co-authors are appropriately credited for their contributions and have been informed of the submission. Violation of these requirements will result in disqualification from the conference.
