

HSC Safety Tips No. (12)

- **1.** Gloves should be both suitable and compatible for the operation(s) performed. Hence, **ALWAYS** review the Manufacturer Material Safety Data Sheets (MMSDS) beforehand for the recommended type of gloves to use.
- 2. Frequently, inspect gloves for signs of degradation, damage, or puncture before use.
- **3.** Wear gloves without touching face or clothes, handling telephones, keyboards, door knobs, water fountains, or elevator buttons, etc. **REMEMBER**, too, to remove beforehand any jewelry that might cut or tear gloves.
- **4.** Remove gloves before leaving the laboratory and entering common use spaces such as elevators or corridors outside your laboratory.
- 5. Keep in mind that disposable gloves are **NOT** suitable for handling aggressive or highly hazardous chemicals, and reusable gloves **SHOULD** be washed **FREQUENTLY** if used for an extended period of time
